Over the years, additions have been added to the original cottage, a garage with garden room in 1980 and a dormer and mud room in 1991. The cottage has been completely renovated, but retains its antique charm. Polhemus Savery DaSilva restored the original building and installed a new brick-clad foundation with finished basement. They also added a porch and rear entry and mud room and a new master bath room.

The resulting home has retained its traditional look and the owners can now enjoy the modern living features.
