Frank and Hattie Hamblin built the two-and-a-half story Queen Anne home in 1900 on land formerly owned by Marcellus Eldredge, a local businessman and legislator who gave the Eldredge Library to the town. The architect's goal was to repair and restore elements of the home to preserve its historic character. The front porch balustrade was renovated and repaired with better materials and methods of construction. The second floor addition replicates the details of the original house with new windows that match the originals. The bay window at the front of the house was replaced with one more consistent with the original construction
